Package Contents:

Mixes package contains: **44 WAV files (16bit, 44.1 khz)**

Stems Package contains: **572 WAV stems (24bit, 44.1khz)**

Also included are “reference” MP3s of all the files so that you can quickly audition and locate the different audio files by name.

Production notes:

All stems are **AS RECORDED. IE: at unity gain with no processing.** The raw files should sound great on their own - that's The Beat Shed recording ethos - but there are certain technical things you might want to try straight away:

- **Flip the phase on the Under Snare channel** - the under snare mic almost always points through the snare drum at the over snare mic - try inverting the polarity and they should be nicely in phase.
- **Experiment with phase/correlation on room mics** - this can have negative or positive effects depending on many factors in your mix. Play around and experiment, just be aware that you can run into phase problems with these channels.
- **Sub kick** - Products from The Beat Shed sometimes come with a sub-bass channel - often on the kick drum. **This is heavy stuff!** You will probably want to low-pass/high-cut this channel quite aggressively, and even then, probably use it quite sparingly - it is a useful colour to add to a mix, not necessarily a main component. **But hey... no wrongs or rights, go experiment!**
